Traffic delays expected on Arden Way at Del Paso Boulevard during bus stop repair work starting Saturday, April 4

The City of Sacramento Department of Transportation is reducing traffic to one lane on eastbound Arden Way between Del Paso Boulevard and Oxford Street, beginning Saturday April 4, for bus stop repairs at the Arden/Del Paso Light Rail Station.

The entire bus turnout lane for passenger drop-off and pick-up is being reconstructed by the City as part of a jointly funded project with Regional Transit.

The light rail station will be open to pedestrians only who are accessing or getting off light rail, however, bus service at the Arden/Del Paso stop will be suspended for the duration of the project. All bus transfers will be made at the nearby Swanston Light Rail Station. Working hours on the project are from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weekdays, with work starting earlier and continuing later on weekends.
