Del Paso Boulevard streetscape concepts at committee meeting

The City of Sacramento is leading an effort to improve Del Paso Boulevard between State Highway 160 and Arden Way. The project will focus on community improvements including sidewalks, enhanced crosswalks, better access to public transit, and new trees and landscaping. This project will build upon previous planning and revitalization efforts along the boulevard.

Funding for the preliminary engineering and environmental documents is provided by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA). The construction of the project is funded through a \$1.46 million grant from the Sacramento Area Council of Governments' Community Design Grant (SACOG) program.
