Dear Interested Party,

The City of Sacramento’s Docks Riverfront Promenade – Phase I project is approximately 50% complete. This project will include improvements to the riverfront west of and including Front Street from O Street to a point south of R Street. The project will include the construction of an approximately 20-foot wide pedestrian and bicycle pathway along the waterfront and a new .4 acre park, which will be known as Pioneer Landing. The project will also include a connection to the R Street Bridge, a riverfront overlook, street furniture, trash receptacles, landscaping, lighting, interpretive signage and an art installation. The Docks Riverfront Promenade – Phase I project is scheduled to be complete in January 2010.

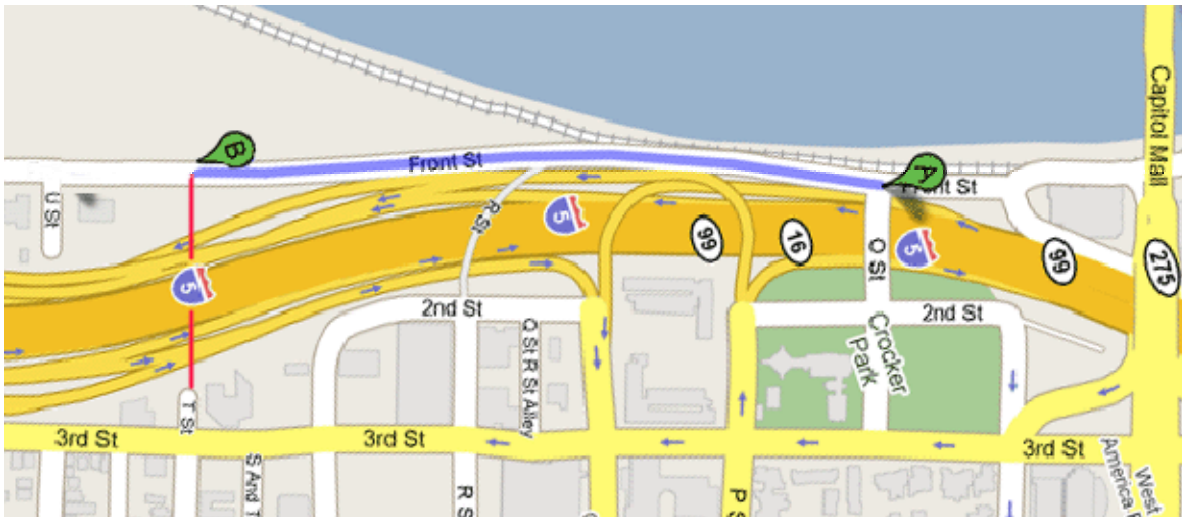
