Water main replacement scheduled

Drivers can expect block by block closures on South Land Park Drive from Ridgeway Drive north to Voltz Drive

The City of Sacramento Department of Transportation has approved the closure of multiple intersections from March 10 to September, so the Department of Utilities can begin phase three of replacing the City's water main in South Land Park.

South Land Park Drive will be closed block by block to accommodate detours, however local access for residents and emergency access will be maintained. In April through September, work will include closing residential side streets: Sunset Road, Hillview Way, and Crestwood Way. On the northern edge of the project in the Moss Drive vicinity, work will be done to retrofit homes with water meters.

The project will require heavy equipment, so the public can expect some dust and noise during working hours.

Work hours are Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m., weather permitting. Work on residential streets will extend from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
