APPOINTMENT:

Thirteen (13) members as follows:

- A. Three (3) Sacramento city residents appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council as follows:
 - 1. One (1) member representative of recycling community and/or businesses
 - 2. One (1) member representative of the integrated waste management industry (may include solid waste collection, transfer, storage, processing, composting, transformation, or disposal)
 - 3. One (1) member representative of residential generators and/or environmental groups
- B. Three (3) members appointed by the County of Sacramento, one (1) of whom shall be a resident of the unincorporated county area, as follows:
 - 1. One (1) member representative of environmental groups
 - 2. One (1) member representative of the waste management industry group and shall be actively or currently engaged in waste and/or recyclables collection, processing, handling or disposal
 - 3. One (1) member representative of residential generators and the general public
- C. Seven (7) members as follows: Two (2) members appointed by each of the Cities of Folsom, Galt, and Citrus Heights; One (1) member appointed by the City of Isleton. No interest group classification requirement.
 - 1. Two (2) residents of Folsom appointed by the Folsom City Council
 - 2. Two (2) residents of Galt appointed by the Galt City Council
 - 3. Two (2) residents of Citrus Heights appointed by the Citrus Heights City Council
 - 4. One (1) resident of Isleton appointed by the Isleton City Council

TERM:

Four (4) year term. Two term limit applies.

MEETING INFO:

Monthly. Time and place selected by a majority vote of the Committee. A majority of eight members present at a meeting are necessary to make a quorum for the committee to take action.

COMPENSATION:

None.

POWERS & DUTIES:

Advise the Sacramento Regional County Solid Waste Authority, the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors and the city councils of Sacramento, Folsom, Isleton, and Galt on:

- 1. All matters relating to the County of Sacramento Integrated Waste Management Plan and all of its planning elements
- 2. All matters relating to integrated waste management, including public education, marketing, source reduction, recycling, composting, transformation, materials recovery/resource recovery, refuse and recyclables, storage, collection, transfer, processing and disposal
