

DESIGN COMMISSION

CONTACT: Planning and Building Department
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APPOINTMENT: Seven (7) members, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. Each member shall have demonstrated interest in urban design, landscape or architectural design, or the physical development of the city.

- A. One (1) Licensed Architect with training or experience in mid and high-rise urban, commercial, institutional, and mixed use projects
- B. One (1) Licensed LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) or equivalent, accredited Architect
- C. One (1) Licensed landscape Architect with training or experience in mid and high-rise urban, commercial, institutional, and mixed use projects
- D. One (1) Licensed contractor with training or experience in mid and high-rise urban, commercial, institutional, and mixed use projects
- E. One (1) Licensed engineer with training or experience in mid and high-rise urban, commercial, institutional, and mixed use projects, with a preference for a structural engineer
- F. One (1) at-large member with a preference for an individual with training or experience in urban planning and urban design
- G. One (1) at-large member with a preference for an individual with training or experience in real estate development, real estate brokerage, or real estate financing

TERM: Three (3) year term. Two term limit applies.

MEETING INFO: Monthly on the third Wednesday at 5:30p.m., Historic City Hall, 2nd Floor Hearing Room, 915 I Street.

COMPENSATION: \$50 per meeting attended, not to exceed \$250.00 in a month

POWERS & DUTIES: The Design Commission's primary responsibilities shall be to develop and recommend to the City Council urban design policies appropriate for inclusion in the General Plan and other regulatory plans and programs of the city, and to develop and recommend design guidelines for the implementation of City Code Chapter 17.132, Design Review. The Design Commission's role in reviewing development projects shall be limited to hearing projects of major significance and appeals of Design Review Director decisions.
