

## JOINT CITY/COUNTY DISABILITIES APPEALS BOARD

**CONTACT:**

Planning and Building Department  
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**APPOINTMENT:**

Five (5) members as follows:

- A. Two (2) members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council:
  1. One member who is experienced in construction
  2. One member who is physically handicapped
- B. Two (2) members appointed by County Board of Supervisors:
  1. One member who is experienced in construction
  2. One member who is physically handicapped
- C. One (1) member appointed by the County Board of Supervisors and Mayor with City Council confirmation, who serves as a representative of the general public. (County Board of Supervisors may appoint an alternate member)

**TERM:**

Three (3) year term. Two term limit applies.

**MEETING INFO:**

Monthly on the third Thursday, if necessary.

**COMPENSATION:**

None.

**POWERS & DUTIES:**

The powers and duties of this board include:

1. To provide for reasonable interpretation and continual review of laws relating to making public facilities and accommodations accessible to physically handicapped persons.
2. Any person aggrieved by an interpretation given by the City or County Building Director relating to provisions of Chapter 7 of Division 5 of Title 1 of the Government Code, Part 5.5 of Division 13 of the Health and Safety Code, applicable provisions of the uniform Building Code or other laws and regulations relating to access for physically handicapped persons to public facilities and accommodations which are enforced by local building officials, may appeal such interpretation to the Board.
