APPOINTMENT: Eleven (11) members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council as follows:

- A. Ten (10) members: One (1) member shall be appointed from each of the city's ten (10) community plan areas, shall reside in the community plan area which he or she represents and shall serve only so long as he or she remains a resident of that community plan area.
- B. One (1) member shall be appointed from the community at-large, shall reside in the city and serve only so long as he or she remains a resident of the city.

TERM: Four (4) year term. Two term limit applies.

MEETING INFO: Monthly on the first Thursday at 7:00 p.m. 2nd Floor Hearing Room, Historic City Hall, 915 I St.

COMPENSATION: \$50.00 per meeting attended, not to exceed \$250.00 per month.

POWERS & DUTIES: The powers and duties of this board include:

To provide recommendations and advice to the City Council and the Department of Parks and Recreation on policies, projects, and other matters pertaining to parks, recreation, trees, and human services affecting the City of Sacramento referred to the Commission by the City Council, the Director of Parks and Recreation, the community or members of the Commission.

Responsibilities of the Commission are as follows:

1. To review and provide recommendations on the development and implementation of the *Parks and Recreation Master Plan* as an element of the City's General Plan;
2. Conduct public hearings and review complaints and other matters pertaining to parks and recreation issues, as requested by the Director of Parks and Recreation or the City Council
3. Conduct annual workshop to review the Dept's annual operating budget and capital improvement plan;
4. Hear appeals from decisions of the Director or Parks and Recreation relating to tree maintenance and removal pursuant to Sections 12.56.120 and 12.64.060 of this Code
5. Meet with neighborhood associations and park user groups to discuss parks and recreation issues and needs
6. Encourage individuals, business, and citizens groups to contribute funds, property and/or volunteer services for the development and operation of parks and recreation facilities.
