POWERS & DUTIES:

The Committee shall be an advisory body to the City Council. It is established for the purpose of reviewing the City's current Charter and making recommendations to the City Council for amendments thereto, and is charged as follows:

1. To review the Sacramento City Charter and to consider whether the Charter meets the current needs of the City and whether the Charter should be amended to meet the City's needs into the future.
2. To make regular progress reports to the City Council during its operation, but no less than one report in each of the months of June, August, and October 2009.
3. To provide a written report of preliminary recommendations to the City Council on or before January 26, 2010.
4. To perform such other duties as the City Council directs by motion or resolution.
