

ALKALI FLAT REDEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

CONTACT: Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency
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APPOINTMENT: Twelve (12) members as follows:

Members shall be elected by residents of Alkali Flat. Recruitment flyers and applications shall be distributed throughout the redevelopment project area to attract individuals who may wish to serve on the Committee. The existence of any vacancies shall not prevent the RAC from carrying out its duties. Committee membership shall be limited to the specified number of persons from each of the following categories:

- A. Tenants – Six (6) residents residing in the Redevelopment Area with a minimum of four (4) renters
- B. Business Owners – Three (3) owners of a business in the Redevelopment Area or their designee
- C. Community Based Organizations – Three (3) community based organizations by their officially designated representative, which organizations are headquartered or conducting substantial activities in the Redevelopment Area
- D. A RAC may include a high school student who resides within the redevelopment project area, as a non-voting member

TERM: Two (2) year term. Two term limit applies.

MEETING INFO: Monthly on the first Thursday at 1117 G Street.

COMPENSATION: \$50.00 per meeting attended.

POWERS & DUTIES: The powers and duties of this board include:

The Redevelopment Area Committee is established to encourage citizen participation in the redevelopment planning process and to provide community forums to propose and review community goals and objectives on matters within the Committee's jurisdiction. The committee is authorized to (a) Provide advice concerning those policy matters which deal with the planning and promotion of residential facilities or replacement housing, for those who may be displaced by project activities, and other policy matters which affect the residents of the Project Area, as requested by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA); and (b) Review and comment upon the planning implementation of the redevelopment and community development plans and programs.
