

NORTH SACRAMENTO REDEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

CONTACT: Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency
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APPOINTMENT: Sixteen (16) members, fourteen (14) nominated by District 2 and two (2) nominated by District 3, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council as follows:

Four (4) members from each of the following categories:

- A. Business Owners (includes non-resident property owners)
- B. Residential Owner Occupants
- C. Residential Tenants
- D. Community Based Organizations (including religious institutions)

The RAC may include a youth representative eligible to serve in any of the four categories, or a high school student residing within the redevelopment project area.

TERM: Two (2) year term. Two term limit applies.

MEETING INFO: Monthly on the 3rd Thursday at 6:00 p.m., North Sacramento School District.

COMPENSATION: \$50.00 per regular meeting attended.

POWERS & DUTIES: The Committee is an advisory committee to the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission, the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of Sacramento, The Sacramento City Council and County Board of Supervisors on all policy matters within the Agency's control that affect the Project Area. The Committee is authorized to:

1. Provide advice regarding policy matters relating to the planning and promotion of residential facilities or replacement housing for those who may be displaced by project activities, and other policy matters which affect the residents of the Project Area.
2. Review and comment upon proposed redevelopment funded activities; assist in formulation of projects and programs to meet identified goals and objectives, including housing programs.
3. Comment upon implementation of community development plans and programs.
