APPOINTMENT: The Corporation shall consist of thirty-three (33) Directors who shall be unrelated persons as follows:

- A. Five (5) voting Directors representing the public sector
 1. City of Sacramento, Mayor or designee
 2. City of Sacramento Council District 1
 3. City of Sacramento City Manager or designee, or city council representative
 4. Sacramento BOS or designee representing greatest portion of the management district
 5. Director or designee from the California State Dept of General Services
- B. Ten (10) Directors representing the Property Owners Council, selected by the Board of Directors from a slate nominated by the Property Owners Council as follows: one (1) each from Old Sacramento property owner, Downtown Plaza, Capital Mall, K Street corridor, Central City, a large property owner, and four (4) property owners at-large.
- C. Eleven (11) Directors representing non-property owners as follows; five (5) business/tenant representatives, one (1) neighborhood representative, three (3) retail representatives for Downtown, Old Sacramento and Downtown Plaza, and one (1) marketing/promotions representative and one (1) Arts & culture representative.
- D. Seven (7) Non-voting Directors representing the Sacramento Regional Transit, Capital Area Development (CADA), Sacramento Housing Redevelopment Agency (SHRA), Sacramento City Police Dept., and Sacramento Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce, Old Sacramento Management and Sacramento Convention & Visitor Bureau.

TERM: Three (3) year term. Officers of the board, one (1) year term.

POWERS & DUTIES: The mission of the Downtown Sacramento Partnership is to establish Downtown Sacramento as the vibrant business, cultural and entertainment destination in the Sacramento region through effective private and public collaboration to benefit residents, visitors and investors. The Downtown Sacramento Partnership (DSP) is a private, non-profit organization dedicated to the improvement of Sacramento's central business district. The DSP oversees maintenance, safety and revitalization programs financed by the Downtown Sacramento Management District, a property assessment district established in 1995 and renewed in 2000 and again in 2005.
