APPOINTMENT: Five (5) members representing the following:

- A. Two (2) members of the City Council appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council
- B. One (1) member Downtown Sacramento Partnership (DSP), appointed by their board
- C. One (1) member River District (formerly known as the Capitol Station District), appointed by their board
- D. One (1) Capitol Area Development Authority (CADA), Exec. Director by virtue of position

TERM: Two (2) year term. No term limits apply; as long as the appointing authority reappoints members.

MEETING INFO: Must meet at least once per year and other meetings will be scheduled on an as needed basis.

COMPENSATION: None.

POWERS & DUTIES: The Downtown Sacramento Revitalization Corporation, a nonprofit public benefit corporation, was established specifically for redevelopment purposes in the Downtown Railyards and Richards Blvd. redevelopment project areas. The DSRC is to assist the City of Sacramento and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento, to alleviate conditions of physical and economic blight in the Downtown Sacramento, Railyards and Richards Boulevard areas.
