1. **Call to Order** – 6:11 p.m.
2. **Roll Call - Present:** Danette Brown, Renee Carter, Alex Eng, Aaron Evans, John Floyd, Walter Kawamoto, Linda Love, Manuel Valencia, John Vigna. **Excused Absences:** Rick Braziel, Ernest Carter, Don Casimere, David Topaz. **Absent:** Julia Vera.
3. **Pledge of Allegiance** - Led by Renee Carter.
4. **Welcome New Member** – Walter Kawamoto, new member from District 2, introduced himself, followed by introductions by each of the Commission members.
5. **Approval of Minutes of May 18, 2006 Meeting** –
Action: Moved, seconded, carried (Vigna/Valencia) to approve the minutes of the May 18, 2006 meeting.
6. **Approval of Second Quarterly Report for 2006** –
Action: Moved, seconded, carried (Vigna/Floyd) to approve the Commission's Second Quarterly Report 2006 to City Council describing CRPC activities from April – June 2006.
7. **Update on Commission Membership** – The City Clerk will once again announce the opening for the Commission seat for District 1 on August 2, 2006. Applications will be accepted for a one-month period.
8. **Update on Vehicle Stop Data Collection Project to include briefing by Staff on: Comparison of Accident Locations, Vehicle Stop Locations, and DUI Checkpoint Locations:**
 - Captain Brian Louie displayed and discussed maps comparing traffic stop locations with both accident locations and with DUI checkpoint locations for 2005.
 - Commission members discussed SPD motor officer deployment policy, traffic stop data compared to parolee location data, and the breakdown of traffic stops into hazardous and non-hazardous.
9. **Commission Comments – Ideas and Questions**
 - Members discussed possible dates for the Fall '06 Weekend Workshop. All Commission seats should be filled by September, and the two weekends at the end of September are being considered as possible dates. Lt. Maccoun will contact John Lamberth about his schedule, and Commission members were asked to send staff member Helga Sprung their preferred dates at hsprung@pd.cityofsacramento.org .
 - Members discussed the current data collection project being conducted by the Lamberth consultants.
 - Lt. Maccoun announced that stipend checks had been mailed. He also announced that the new Scantron forms would be in use by August 1st and

that trainers would be present at all roll call locations to explain the correct way to record data and to answer officers' questions.

10. Public Comment – Matters Not on the Agenda

Officer Mark Chapman noted that the top traffic stop locations are spread throughout the City and cited the issue of multi-jurisdictional intersections.

11. Adjournment - There being no further business of the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
