4. **Update on Commission Membership** –
 - ❖ Welcome to Alani Cridge, the newly appointed representative from District 1;
 - ❖ The posting for the vacant Commission seat for District 3 is open for applications until 5 p.m. Friday, February 29, 2008;
 - ❖ The posting for the vacant Commission set for District 8, is now closed. One application was received and is currently under review.
5. **Approval of Minutes of the January 17, 2008 Meeting** –

6. **Discussion on Vehicle Stop Study Stakeholder Memo** –
 - ❖ Chair Crystal Taylor distributed a draft of a memo to community stakeholders about the progress of the study for the Commission members to review, discuss and finalize;
 - ❖ Communications specialist Michele McCormick distributed a list of community stakeholders who will receive the completed memo. Individuals and groups were included on the list due to their involvement in and interest in local civil rights issues and for their participation in the Commission’s September 2007 Community/Police workshop.
7. **Discussion on Vehicle Stop Study Commission Report** –
Michele McCormick:
 - ❖ Discussed the Commission’s goal to prepare a report detailing the members’ extensive and continued participation in the vehicle stop study to append to the study results report;
 - ❖ Announced that she would draft the report for review by Chair Crystal Taylor and Commission members.
8. **Discussion on Vehicle Stop Study Rollout Plan** –
Michele McCormick discussed several options for meeting with community stakeholders in an inclusive and timely manner at the time of the study report release.

9. Operational Update on Police Department Activities –

Deputy Chief Brian Louie:

- ❖ Briefed Commission members on directed patrol activity in the area surrounding McKinley Park in East Sacramento as a response to an active burglary series;
- ❖ Announced that 92% of the study period data had been recovered, although it will not be used in the vehicle stop study, and that the data for the period from October 1, 2007 to the present was 91% complete.


