Fastest hands in Sacramento demonstrate the skills that are taking them to the World Sport Stacking Championships: Wednesday, March 4th, 2:45 – 3:45 p.m.

Sacramento, California, March 2, 2009—Local youth with lightening-fast hands will hold a special sport stacking demonstration for the media as a run-up to the 4th Annual City of Sacramento Sport Stacking Tournament. Having already qualified for the World Sport Stacking Championships in Denver, where they plan to break a couple of world records, the youth are eager to showcase their skills for local media. The **Sport Stacking Demonstration** will take place this **Wednesday**, from **2:45 – 3:45 p.m.** at **Heron Elementary - 5151 Bandfield Drive**.



Sport stacking consists of contestants stacking and unstacking cups in predetermined sequences while being timed. Top "stackers" can stack and unstack cups in less than three seconds.
