

Water with the Weather

Sacramento's rainy season is almost here. With cooler temperatures and shorter days, now is a great time to evaluate your watering needs and adjust your sprinkler timer.


Change your clock, change your sprinkler. When you change your clock back to standard time this November, adjust or turn off your sprinklers. The cooler temperatures and rainy weather mean you need less water for your lawn.

Determine how much water your lawn really needs. Call (916) 808-5454 today for a free Water Wise House Call. We'll send a Water Conservation Specialist to your home to help you determine how much water your landscape really needs - both in the dry and rainy seasons.

Check the weather and water accordingly. Remember to only water on your scheduled watering day and check local weather reports to determine if rain is coming. If it is, turn off your sprinklers and let nature water your lawn for the day.

Consider a Rain Sensor. Rain Sensors are easy to install on most irrigation systems and will override your system to keep it from watering on rainy days. Rain Sensors can be purchased at most home improvement stores and cost approximately \$30.
